

Stadium Protocol for semi-finals and medal games

- All substitutes/replacements are to be on or behind their own benches and inside their own technical zone. Failure to comply will result in substitutes/replacements being sent into stands.
- All substitutions/replacements will be made through the 4th official.
- Sin-binned players shall report to the 4th/5th official.
- Coaches and management from both teams are to be inside their own technical zone, outside the ropes or behind the dead ball line. At Rotary Stadium the ropes on the grandstand side of the pitch shall be the fence immediately in front of the grandstand. Failure to comply will result in being sent into the stands.
- Coaches may go on the field (including in-goal area) only at half-time or to attend to an injured player.
- Teams may send water to their team using two water carriers NOTE: this can only
 happen when the play is dead because of injury or after a try has been scored...
 NOT during penalty kicks at goal. A off the pitch player may act as a kicking tee
 helper. Both tee carriers and water carriers are not to wear team jerseys or school
 colours which match the playing uniforms
- Players may come to the touch line adjacent to the technical zone to receive water. Water bottles must not be thrown on to the field of play.
